PACIFIC SPORTS GROUP LAUNCHES NEW VISION FOR WORLD BASEBALL LEAGUE

Pacific Sports Group (PSG), Los Angeles, CA, announced its agreement with former MLB players and owners of land in the Dominican Republic to acquire their real estate in Puerto Plata to be its first location for a team to join its new World Baseball League (WBL), expected to start operations in the spring of 2026.



According to Chairman and President of PSG, Los Angeles attorney Robert Young explained: “We are thrilled to begin our journey to change the landscape of professional baseball. We hope to expand our great game of baseball and bring it back to prominence as our national pastime on an international scale and remembering always... It’s about the game. We expect to begin play in the Caribbean, Hawaii and the West Coast of the US with players and fans owning an equal interest with us, all to be equal partners in our journey.”

Young, the former owner of 4 minor league teams in the Golden Baseball League and the Pacific Association, remarked: “It is a natural evolution of our national pastime, and we are excited by the real estate development opportunities that continue to present themselves which will be our key to support and sustain the WBL.”

Each team will have its own new stadium along with conjunctive commercial, residential, and retail development to support its infrastructure. PSG’s Pacific Sports Institute will have a location at each facility and be affiliated with a local university to coordinate its efforts, not only for the players, but for the local community as well.

The company is represented by the investment banking firm of Wildland Capital, headed by Todd Barton, who is negotiating with developers to be exclusive partners, and is fielding inquiries from many.

“The response has been off the charts,” exclaimed Barton “and the company is poised to launch!”
